NOTE: Premises are registered for keeping either (a) gunpowder or (b) mixed explosives. (Please tick appropriate box).

In premises registered for gunpowder, only gunpowder and cartridges or charges for cannon or blasting made with gunpowder, and not containing within themselves their own means of ignition, may be kept.

For any other explosives, whether with or without gunpowder, the premises must be registered for mixed explosives:

this applies even when the other explosives consist only of small arm cartridges, or safety fuse made with gunpowder and, if gunpowder or safety fuse is kept, a police licence in accordance with the Control of Explosives Regulations 1991 (S.I. 1991 No. 1531) is required.

A police certificate must be obtained from the Chief Officer of Police in the District if explosives other than gunpowder and cartridges made therewith, small arm nitro-compound, safety cartridges, percussion caps, safety fuse and fireworks are kept.

(N.B. This Form can also be used for the annual renewal of Registration).

\*A registration for mixed explosives' covers the keeping of gunpowder, whether other explosives be or be not kept therewith, subject, of course, to the provisions as to such keeping (O.'s in C., Nos. 16,16A and 16 B). But a registration for gunpowder only does not cover the keeping of other explosives, except to the extent authorized by sect. 44 (sect. 22).

Please note that fireworks, cartridges, toy caps and air bag detonators fall within the category of 'mixed explosives'.

Mode A storage only applies when a safe and secure building is used exclusively for the purpose of storing explosives.
